# "13 DAYS/13 DIAS"—Scathing Political Extravaganza

"13 DAYS/13 DIAS," the new work by the San Francisco Mime Troupe. examines the Chiapas Uprising when a Mayan peasant army appeared out of nowhere to challenge the "new world order." The work features traditional Mexican choreography and costumes, and an original score based on Conidos and Rancheros music.

Anything but silent, this is scathingly funny, thought-provoking, explosively charged, and vocal political theater. Collaborating with Academy Award-nominated filmmaker Lourdes Portillo, the S.F. Mime Troupe deftly combines film and video with live action in a brand new, cutting-edge, multimedia extravaganza.

"13 Days" traces the uprising through the upheaval it causes in the lives of five principal characters: a Mayan village leader; the Mexican Army commander in Chiapas; his daughter, who sees herself as a citizen of the global economy; the daughters mother, who tries to be modern and "Mexican"; and a 30-something Gringo who is seeking the simple life of Mexico.
