- Kamala Harris is a lifelong environmental, conservation, and climate justice champion
 - As San Francisco District Attorney, she established the first Environmental Justice unit in the country.
 - As California Attorney General, she prosecuted oil companies and polluters.
 - As Vice President, she helped champion the 30x30 conservation initiative.
 - And she cast the tie breaking vote on the Inflation Reduction Act, the largest investment in clean energy and climate in history.
- In contrast, Donald Trump denies the existence of climate change. He has said that he will leave the Paris Accords once again and increase oil and gas drilling everywhere — in return for the deluge of donations he has received from Big Oil. Also, Project 2025, the blueprint for a second Trump term, has called for the elimination of the Hurricane Forecast Center and the National Weather Service.
